Zedua Experiments

Title: Beady Foam Turtle

Materials Required:

- 1. Green & Yellow Fun Foam
- 2. Blue & Yellow cabochons
- 3. 8x10 double Tape Sheet
- 4. Diamond Beadlets
- 5. Kreinik Dimensional Threads: Gold Braid Assortment
- 6. Scissors
- 7. Knife

Procedure:

- 1. Trace the shape of turtle, shell, legs and tails onto the green and yellow fun foam. Cut them out carefully.
- 2. Use a sharpedged knife to cut out the holes in the "shell" layer of the pattern
- Peel back the white back side of your double tape and place the yellow body layer on the tape.
- 4. Take another shape and repeat to apply tape to the second side.
- 5. Press from the center with your fingers to smooth out any air bubbles
- Place the cut out feet and tail pieces on the tape, and then align the yellow body shape with the bottom green shape. Press to adhere firmly.
- 7. Now take both the body piece and shell piece and tape them together.
- 8. Use your gold threads to make a pattern on tortoise "shell".
- 9. When finished, press all threads firmly into the tape.
- 10. Place your design in a tray or ziploc bag and pour beadlets over the exposed tape.
- 11. Cover fully. Tap to remove excess beadlets.
