

# Zedua Experiments

## Title: Best Friend's Wreath

### Materials Required:

1. Instant Decoupage Sealer & Finish
2. Aleene's Easy Flow Tacky Glue™
3. Foil
4. Pencil
5. Mounting squares,
6. Foam adhesive
7. Plastic wrap
8. Scrap white paper
9. Ribbon, 1" grosgrain coordinating color, 1 yard
10. Photos
11. Gift wrap
12. Scissors
13. Brush, 1" flat
14. Hole punches in same sizes as tags, if possible
15. Bamboo skewer or chopstick
16. Cardstock, coordinating colors with gift wrap
17. Metal rim tags: 3 sizes, round and 2 sizes, decorative or flower shapes
18. Cardboard

### Procedure:

1. Draw a 9 inch circle on cardboard. Draw 6 inch circle centered on inside of 9 inch circle. This will make a ring about 1-½ inch wide. Cut out ring.  
Note:  
Use two bowls, that are close to these measurements as a template.
2. From one color of cardboard, tear strips approximately 2 inches wide. Take instant decoupage and brush it on front of ring. Brush on back of each small piece of cardboard as it i

s wrapped around ring. Brush decoupage over the top as you proceed. Cut an additional piece of cardboard slightly smaller than ring and decoupage to finish off back. Let it dry.

3. Place a piece of scrap paper on top of tags. Use a pencil to draw around inside edge of metal and create a pattern of different shapes and sizes of tags.
4. Use this pattern to cut pieces of gift wrap and cardboard. Note: Use a circle punch where possible to create paper circles. This saves time
5. Decoupage papers onto one side of key tags and papers. Let it dry.
6. Cut photos in a circle. Brush decoupage to a slightly larger circle of cardboard. Brush decoupage to largest flower tags.
