Title: Butterfly Pocket Pal

Materials Required:

- 1. Quick Dry Tacky Glue
- 2. Wood pieces, assorted sizes and shapes
- 3. Paper punches: 1/8", 3/16", 1/4"
- 4. Black marker
- 5. Acrylic paint
- 6. Embroidery floss (to hang flower)
- 7. Wire
- 8. Craft sticks
- 9. Craft foam

10.1/4" flat brush

Procedure:

- Glue the wood pieces together. Glue the tip of craft stick to back of the figur e, make sure there is space enough to insert into a pocketLet it dry.
- 2. Using ¼" brush, paint with any acrylic paint colors as desired on the butterfly, paint stick green. L et it dry.
- 3. Glue all trims into appropriate place.
- 4. Take wire and bend it like antennae and insert into the top of butterfly.
- 5. Take craft foam for trim, flower, leaf and body, and embroidery flo ss to hang.
- 6. Dot eyes using black marker.
