

Zedua Experiments

Title: CD Case Photo Frame

Make a beautiful and colorful photo frame recycling few of your old CD collection.

Materials Required:

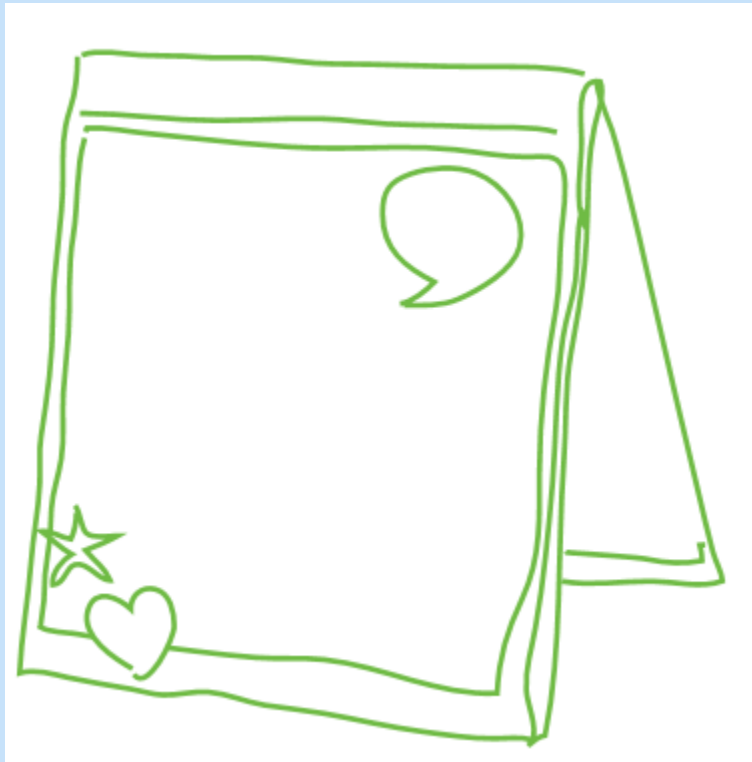
1. An empty CD case (the type made out of clear plastic)
2. An assortment of craft supplies to decorate the frame
3. A photo to be framed
4. A piece of cardboard, about the size of the CD case.
5. You can use cardboard packaging, e.g. from a cereal box or carton.
6. Scissors
7. Glue
8. Sticky tape

Procedure:

1. Take a photo and trim the photo to the right size so that it will just fit inside the case.

Note: Keep in mind that the hinge of the case will be at the top of the frame.

2. Place the photo against the back of the CD case, so that you can see the photo through the plastic.
3. Take the cardboard and trim to the right size so that it will fit into the case. Place it up against the back of the photo and secure it into position using small pieces of sticky tape. The cardboard will protect your photo from falling out.
4. Decorate the front of the photo frame using any craft materials.
