Title: Celebrate! Star Ornament

Making ornaments is one of the favourite pastime for all the girls. Here is one such activity that will keep them and busy and get them a beautiful ornament at the end.

Materials Required:

1. STYROFOAM Brand Products: o Star, 6"
2. Fabric: scraps in bright colors
3. Ribbon: fabric and curling ribbon in festive colors
4. Ribbon, 1/2" x 1 yd., metallic gold
5. Scissors
6. Wooden skewer, knitting needle or other tool with point
7. Straight pin
8. Thick white craft glue
9. Low temperature glue gun and glue sticks

Procedure:

1. Cut or tear fabric into strips $\frac{3}{4}$ inch wide x 2- $\frac{1}{2}$ inch - 3 inch long. Cut fabric ribbons into 3 inch lengths. Curl 4 inch lengths of curling ribbon; snip ends and gently split ribbon to create a cluster of narrow curls.
2. Glue $\frac{1}{2}$ inch ribbon around outside edge of star using low temperature glue.
3. Place dab of glue on star center a ribbon or fabric piece on glue and push $\frac{1}{4}$ inch into foam using skewer (be careful not to punch through the back of star).
4. Cover star using variety of fabrics and ribbons in bright and fun colors.
5. Tie loop in 8 inch length of $\frac{1}{2}$ inch ribbon; pin and glue to top point for hanger.
