Title: Make Your Own Weather Vane

What is a weather vane?

A **Weather vane**, Wind vane, or Weathercock is an instrument showing the direction of the wind. It is typically used as an architectural ornament to the highest point of a building

Challenge: Can you make Weather Vane on your own?

Materials Required:

- 1. An ice-cream container lid (or an old food container lid)
- 2. Scissors or a craft knife (use adult help)
- 3. A marker (felt pen)
- 4. A skewer
- 5. A straw
- 6. A pin

Procedure:

- 1. Trace a triangle and a rectangle on the ice-cream container lid with the marker and cut it out.
- 2. Cut a slit in both ends of the straw and slide the triangle in one end and the rectangle in the other and glue into place(it looks like an arrow).
- 3. Take a pin and push it through the exact middle of the straw and then into the flat end of the skewer.
- 4. Take this experiment outside and observe the movement of the straw. Now you can see what is
